Science Fair Guidelines for Division A (Kindergarten, First, and Second Graders):

1. Participants will make a poster about a science topic or experiment they have conducted. The poster should be on a white poster board of standard size (approximately 22" by 28") and should be able to hang on a wall. The poster boards will be displayed at the science fair. Poster boards should be brought to school on Thursday, February 21, 2019 during the school day no later than 2:00 pm.
2. No experiments will be performed at the fair. Students may complete an experiment at home and illustrate it through pictures placed on the poster board.
3. Students may examine a collection of items instead of performing an experiment. Ask a one sentence question that you will find the answer to by collecting something. For example, "What kinds of leaves are in my backyard?"
4. Please write your name(s), grade(s) and room number(s) on the front of your poster, under your project title.
5. All participants will receive a certificate of participation.
6. Some projects may be chosen to be displayed at Barnes & Noble on Saturday, February 23rd. These projects will be returned on Monday, February 25th. You may choose to opt out by checking the box on the form below.
